Athletics Canada is pleased to provide National Team Coaching opportunities to our Canadian Coach Membership during the 2017 competition season. The following is the selection criteria for all coaching positions related to 2017 National Teams to ensure that our National Team athletes experience a positive high performance environment, conducive to producing personal and seasonal best results. The CTO/Head Coach is responsible for the implementation of these criteria and all decisions relating to the selection of the National Team Coach positions

1 GENERAL INFORMATION

1.1 Important Dates

1.2 Eligibility

- Must be a registered member of Athletics Canada at time of selection and through the end of the national team event
- Must declare interest as per the dates outlined in Section 1.1
- Must be a current member in good standing of the Coaches Association of Canada
- Must have a current security check completed – Sterling Back Check, Interpol, etc.
- Must sign the [AC Team Coach Conduct Policy](#)
- Must have a passport valid for up to 6 months after the national team event

1.3 Final Selection Date and Team Announcement

The CTO/Head Coach will make final coaching selections by **November 30, 2016**. AC will announce the selections through established communication channels (Branches, AC website, bulletin) and coaches selected to a national team event will be contacted directly

2 SELECTION PROCESS

2.1 Selection Factors

The following factors will be considered during selection by the CTO/Head Coach

- Event specific Coaching Certification Levels (min. Performance Coach NCCP Certified)
- Provincial ranking – see Section 2.2
- Previous reviews and or references
- Coach event preferences
- Previous National Team Event Coach experience
- Gender diversity
- Provincial diversity
- Language diversity
- Mentorship opportunities – ensure appropriate balance of experience
- Team player with ability to adhere to Athletics Canada’s team objectives and policies

2.2 Provincial Ranking

Each province will assemble a list of coach applicants from their province and rank them in priority order for selection. After the declaration deadline, the provinces will provide the CTO/Head Coach their priority list of applicants which will be used as part of his selection process

3 ATHLETICS CANADA TEAM COACH POLICY

The Athletics Canada “Team Coach/Personal Coach Policy and Selection for Major Events” document and the “AC Team Coach Conduct Policy” must be signed prior to a coach’s selection and appointment to a team. This document can be found [here](#)
