



Athletics Canada Commonwealth Games Team – Additional Quota and Athlete Replacement Policy

Originally Commonwealth Games Canada (CGC) had offered Athletics Canada thirty-six (36) able-bodied athlete quota slots for able-bodied athletes for the 2018 Gold Coast Commonwealth Games.

*Commonwealth Games Canada (CGC) has advised Athletics Canada that additional slots may become available if a selected athlete later withdraws from the team. **CGC is not obliged to reallocate these slots to Athletics Canada.***

The CGC has indicated that any new slots, or reallocated slots, are to be used to prioritize and/or strengthen our most realistic top-5 opportunities at the Gold Coast Games.

Therefore should a new slot become available due to CGC offering an additional place, or due to an athlete withdrawing from the team, the National Teams Committee will select additional athletes as follows:

- 1. Athletes will be added to selected eligible relay teams until each team reaches a maximum of six (6) athletes in total.*
- 2. Additional slots are then to be allocated to remaining eligible athletes according to the Selection Process for Able-Bodied Athletes (see section 3.2 of the Commonwealth Games Selection Criteria).*
